



A Fine Weekend of Racing at the Telemark Nordic 2022 Teck BC Track Attack Championships

February 28, 2022, West Kelowna, BC: Telemark Nordic Club successfully hosted the 2022 Teck BC Track Attack Championships February 26th and 27th. Twenty one clubs from across BC and Washington State, and more than 250 racers born 2009 - 2012 raced in three events over two days. Track Attack (formerly known as Midgets) was first held at Telemark in 2001, the event was also held at Telemark in 2017, and this was the largest Track Attack event ever held, which speaks to the growing interest and passion for cross country skiing in BC.

“Events like these are opportunities to try out racing in a fun and supportive environment but it’s also about encouraging a love of being active for life,” said Brent Hobbs, Telemark Nordic Club Board President.

Team Telemark showed some excellent results with five podium finishes and nine top ten performances in the Classic race including Jake Ulansky placing first and Owen Elliot placing second out of 32 2011 boys, Grace Szabadi in second out of 22 in 2012 Girls. Also on the podium were Rio Sentesy fifth out of 37 in 2010 Boys and Kai Redman fifth out of 28 in 2009 Boys.

In the 1.5km Relay, the team once again stepped up the podium with third place for the Boys including Chase Plghin, Kai Redman, Rio Sentesy, Jake Ulansky and the Girls Relay Team of Bronwyn Sprules, Allie Bridge, Teagan Sprules and Madeleine Carroll.

In the Sprint Qualifier, the team enjoyed several top ten results and a fifth place finish for Chase Pighin in 2010 Boys, first and third place finish for Jake Ulansky and Elias Walker, respectively, with a fifth place for Owen Elliott in the 2011 Boys. Eva Ball placed fifth in 2011 Girls and Grace Szabadi placed third in 2012 Girls.
