



Team Telemark Represented at FIS Nordic Junior World Championships at Whistler, BC

Jan. 25, 2023: Telemark Nordic Race Team is pleased to announce that Garrett Siever will represent Canada at the 2023 FIS Nordic Junior/U23 Cross-Country World Ski Championships at Whistler Olympic Park from January 27 to February 5, 2023! Qualifying at the Nordiq Canada Selection Trials held at Caledonia Nordic Jan. 18-21, 2023. This annual competition is rarely hosted outside of Europe and is the largest event of its kind at the Park since the 2010 Olympics.

Garrett has trained with Head Coach Adam Elliot for a decade, starting out in the Youth Development program as a Jackrabbit. He is a resident of West Kelowna, BC. "Garrett was able to easily take the top U20 spot in the 20 km Classic Mass Start race which automatically qualified him for the World Junior Championships in Whistler. We are proud of all our Telemark Nordic skiers who showed incredible grit and delivered great performances in Prince George. Our young team shows a lot of promise for the future," he said.

Telemark previously sent Gareth Williams to the U20 World Championships in 2017. He also represented Canada in the U23 World Championships in 2018 and 2019. Hannah Mehain qualified for the U20 World Championships in 2018. Hannah also went on to represent Canada at the U23 World Championships in 2019 and 2020
